Oral presentation grading

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The oral presentations will be graded according to the following criteria.

- Preparation: Outline, discussion meetings.
- Content: Correctness and precision of the statements and proofs, covering the main result(s) and some applications, structure of the talk, balance between technical details and conveying ideas.
- Clarity: Clarity of the explanations, use of illustrative examples, use of pictures and diagrams, flow of the talk.
- Answering questions: Providing relevant, concise answers to questions if they fall within the scope of the talk.
- Board work: Legible and big enough writing, leaving material long enough before erasing it, not hiding the writing by standing in front of it, highlighting some key parts, keeping important formulas and statements for later.
- Poise and delivery: Clear enunciation, audible voice, eye contact with the audience, comfortable pace and intonation.
- Use of time: Not going over 50 minutes (including some time for questions), not finishing before 40 minutes, not rushing the end, not starting too slowly.
