APPLICATION PROCESS

Step One: Apply for admission at www.uregina.ca/admissions/apply.html (or for Nursing at www.sasknursingdegree.ca) and pay the **\$100 application fee**.

Step Two: Submit a transcript to Enrolment Services by **March 15, 2025** (or for Nursing to Sask Polytechnic by **March 15, 2025**) to meet the Early Application Deadline.

Step Three: Check to ensure that you are registered in the courses you need for Final Admission (see reverse), and complete these courses by **June 30, 2025**.

Step Four: Submit your Final Official Transcript from the BC Ministry of Education or the Yukon high school that you attended, after graduation, by **August 1, 2025.**
