

## Suggested Academic Plan for ECON Co-op Students

Before the work term, students **MUST** successfully complete the following:

- ENGL 100 and one of ENGL 110, PHIL 100, RLST 245, 248, SOST 110;
- At least two ECON courses;
- At least 45 credit hours (including the semester in which students are applying into the program) and no more than 84 credit hours completed; and
- have a minimum PGPA of 67.5% and a major GPA of at least 70%

**The Department of Economics HIGHLY RECOMMENDS the completion of ECON 201, 202, and 224 before the first work term.**

The Department of Economics <b>HIGHLY RECOMMENDS</b> the completion of ECON 201, 202, and 224 before the first work term.</p>	

YEAR 3	<b>ECON 310;</b> <b>ECON 351;</b> One of ECON 311/341/353/354/361/363/364/372	<b>Work Term II:</b> The Department of Economics HIGHLY RECOMMENDS the completion of ECON 301, 302 and 351 before the second work term.
