Dear Students.

One of the concerted efforts we have made to improve your practicum experience is to provide you with information that will assist you in making the appropriate decision for your practicum placement. This document is intended to provide students with information on the available practicum placements out there*. It is also intended to assist you in researching the organizations that interest you. *However, students are NOT allowed to solicit or contact the various organizations listed below for practicum placements*. It is the job of the Justice Studies Practicum Office, to solicit and ensure that all students in the Department have a practicum placement. Therefore, if you find an organization on the list below or somewhere else that you are interested in doing your practicum with, provide the placement and contact person's information to the Practicum Office to follow up on your behalf.

This is a live document, which means, it will be updated from time to time to maintain its relevance to the student's current needs. The document is arranged in alphabetical order by *city location*. However, there is a separate category for Federal Government and international organizations. As you (the student) go through this document, it is important to know that you will be placed at a practicum in order of preference in the following order:

- 1. Advanced Practicum (JS490) applicants and students in their 4th year of study
- 2. Police Studies majors applying for Introductory Practicum placements, and the
- 3. Order of application, i.e. first come first serve.

Only advanced practicum applicants will be allowed to do their practicum outside of the province of Saskatchewan or internationally. However, in the case where an *introductory* applicant lives outside of the province of Saskatchewan, they may be allowed to do their practicum in the city where they live following proof of residence.

Some practicum placement organizations may require the applicant to do an interview and undergo background checks. In the case of Police Studies majors, some may be required to undergo extensive internal or external security clearances by their placement organization. Therefore, before applying for practicum, it is important that you speak to your Practicum Coordinator about your practicum placement interest.

It is our wish that you'll have a successful practicum placement. Our goal in the Justice Studies Department is to provide you with a lifetime experience that would have a long-lasting effect on your future career.
