 Applications categorized:

 A = deemed acceptable

 Eligible supervisor

 Competitive GPA (i.e., 80% overall)

 Intention to pursue graduate studies

 Quality of written application

 X = deemed unacceptable

 No supervisor named

 GPA not competitive

 Rationale for applying vague/inappropriate

 B = all other applications

 Faculty other applications

 - Faculty members given list of eligible students Supervisor will advise UHC
 Applicants will be notified of results

Conditional acceptance 000

- o If accepted, you may receive a letter of conditions
 - Conditions MUST be met by August 31
 - Failure to complete the conditions will void the acceptance

• Streams o Clinical o Experimental o Both require a significant research component o Social, developmental, cognitive, health, forensic, neuro, industrial/organization, stats/methods, counselling, school, community etc. Reality Getting in is tough • Minimum GPA requirements (depends on the school) . Most programs admit 6-10 students each year Examples: • 5% of applicants are admitted at SFU • 7% of clinical applicants admitted to U of R **See CPA graduate guide** • Research experience o Volunteer in a lab (or two...) ANY lab • Experience and letters o Be willing to do very basic tasks o Not likely paid o Presentation/ publication possibilities

NOTE. GREs are no required by many programs

- o Subject
 - Can be taken in Regina or Saskatoon
 - Offered at one location or both in April, September, and October (typically)
 - . Must sign up ahead of time
- o General
 - Regina
 - Saskatoon
 - At home (only during COVID likely)

- o Costly
- o School selection
 - · Identify schools of interest
 - · E-mail potential advisors
 - · Your interests
 - · Inquire if taking students
- o Start process summer before applications due

Grad School Application Process o Statement of interest • Tailor to individual faculty members • Have someone read it over Must be provided to your referees • "Do not write a lot of schmaltz about wanting to save the world." · Show focused interest, with flexibility Application Process o Reference letters Required materials Other guidelines • Timeline Sending letters Adding schools to your list o Make it easy for the letter writer! Alternatives o Experimental Requires Ph.D. o Clinical • Can practice with MA in some provinces (may change) • Registration process more difficult Consider · Counselling, school psychology, social
