WHMIS

"Undergrad Mandatory WHMIS (Engineering)" is a required (but brief) online safety course for 'new' Engineering students. This includes new admissions, re-admissions, faculty transfers, and new exchange students.

If you began classes in Spring/Summer 2024 or Fall 2024, this WHMIS course must be completed before the next time you register for classes. **Please check UR Courses for WHMIS about a week after the Add/Drop deadline (September 17th)**. Upon successful completion, your WHMIS certificate will be valid for 3 years. Make sure you download your certificate, as this will notify us of your completion.

If a student does not complete WHMIS before their next registration time ticket opens, a hold is placed on their account. Registration cannot be processed until WHMIS is finished. Although the Faculty general office receives notification of your exam completion, it can take 1-2 business days to remove the registration hold. Please complete the exam and download your certificate well in advance of your registration date.

ACADEMIC ACTION:

If you have received an email (to your preferred or uregina – check both) regarding your academic action and you have questions please email or book an appointment with our academic advisor, Tina Lei to discuss. Ting.Lei@uregina.ca

Probation: A student is placed on probation if their UGPA has slipped below 60%. The student has 24 credit hours (8 courses) to raise their UGPA to a 60%.

Continued Probation: A student is placed on continued probation if their UGPA has not been raised to a 60% and courses continue to be counted toward the 24 credit hour maximum before MW (Must Withdraw).

MW (Must Withdraw): If a student fails to raise their UGPA to 60% within 24 credit hours of going on probation they will be placed on MW. This is a 12 month absence from campus. The ARP program may be taken. Courses taken at another institution during this time will not count for transfer credit.

RTD (Require to Discontinue): If a student fails a course 2 times and has a UGPA below 60% they will be RTD'd from the Faculty. This is an 8 month withdrawal from Engineering. The student can transfer to another Faculty or to the Academic Recovery Program through Student Services. Courses taken during the RTD period at another institution will not be accepted as transfer credit.

If a student 2 time fails a course and their UGPA is 60% or above they will not be RTD'd.

If a student fails a course for the 3rd time they will be RTD'd regardless of their UGPA. If a student fails English for a 3rd time, it is an automatic 2 year MW.

Note: A student will not be accepted back into Engineering from an RTD or an MW without a 60% UGPA. If a student has been RTD'd or MW'd more than once (or a combination of the two) their UGPA must be 65% to be readmitted to Engineering.

COMPUTER LABS

The Faculty of Engineering and Applied Science computer labs, ED 116.2 and ED 489, are available for drop-in use (when not already in use for classes/labs). Available hours are 7:00 a.m. to 10:45 p.m. Please remember that doors to these labs must not be propped open, and no food or drinks are permitted. This includes water bottles. General access will be removed for one week if these rules are violated. Thanks in advance for your cooperation!
