National Indigenous History Month National Indigenous Peoples Day - June 21, 2024

The National Indigenous History Month in Canada is a time to honour the stories, achievements and resilience of Indigenous Peoples.

The weekly themes for 2024 are:

June 1 to 9: Environment, traditional knowledge and territory

June 10 to 16: Children and youth

June 17 to 23: Languages, cultures and arts

June 24 to 30: Women, girls and 2SLGBTQI+ people

June is also the month to celebrate the resilience, talent and contributions of the 2SLGBTQIA+ communities. In many communities, Pride events are celebrated during the summer months.

The first large-scale gatherings for 2SLGBTQIA+ rights took place in Ottawa and Vancouver in 1971. 1973 saw Pride events held in several Canadian cities.

We can show solidarity with the 2SLGBTQIA+ communities by learning more, and through visible symbols such as wearing a Pride Pin and participation in the Pride Parade.

It was taken up by the i2i Intergenerational society and five other school groups from Quebec, Manitoba, Ontario, Newfoundland, and British Columbia.

International Day for Countering Hate Speech - June 18, 2024
