Positions include:

Specialized Event Staff:

- <u>Basketball: Shot-clock, scoreboard, scoreboard wings (player stats)</u> on campus
 - An understanding of basketball and the rules is required.
 - These positions work at the score table and must be able to work together and communicate with basketball officials.
 - Must be able to work all or most home basketball games. There are typically 5 home weekends, teams play Friday and Saturday evening and there are two games per night.
 - Previous experience is an asset.
- <u>Game Day Host on and off-campus</u>
 - Responsible for in-game promotions including halftime and intermission contests and crowd activation, talking on a microphone.
 - Must be friendly and outgoing; this position must approach fans for participation in in-stand promo games and halftime or intermission contests on the court or on-ice.
 - Wears a headset to communicate with DJ and digital media team (Basketball/Volleyball)
 - Coordinates with the mascot for fan engagement
- <u>Music/DJ on and off-campus</u>
 - The DJ role will be responsible for all music; pre-game, in-game and post-game.
 - DJ coordinates with the game-day host and public address announcer and plays music, turns on microphones and plays sounds for promotional games such as Name the Tune and Finish the Lyric.
 - DJ equipment includes an iPad, headset, sound equipment box, and applications such as Spotify and Soundboard.
- <u>Mascot (Reggie) on and off-campus</u>
 - Duties include wearing the mascot costume as an official representative of the University of Regina and Cougars varsity sport.
 - Must interact with the crowd and hype fans up, pose for pictures with children and use "Go Cougars" signs for fan engagement.
 - Must be outgoing and good with people.

Business Operations Staff

Student Manager, Ticketing

- Responsible for overseeing all ticketing operations at on-campus Cougar events (Basketball/Volleyball/Soccer)
- Set up of ticketing laptops, terminals, and scanners.
- Take payment from fans, scan tickets or check student identification and stamp hands.
- Oversees other ticket staff on shift.
- Shifts are outdoors at the UofR Turf Field (Soccer) and indoors at CKHS Gym 3 (Basketball, Volleyball).
- Must be reliable, organized, outgoing and available to work Friday and Saturday evenings, and some Sunday afternoons.
- Must be fluent in English, both written and verbally.
- Must be able to handle cash and understand Canadian currency.
- A minimum of one year's previous customer service experience is an asset.

Student Manager, Merchandise

- Responsible for overseeing all merchandise sales at Cougar events (Hockey & Soccer)
- Set up of merchandise displays and sales platforms at events.
- Manage student staff.
- Must have available personal transportation for off-campus events.
- Must be reliable, organized, outgoing and available to work Friday and Saturday evenings, and some Sunday afternoons.
- Must be fluent in English, both written and verbally.
- Must be able to handle cash and understand Canadian currency.
- A minimum of one year's previous customer service experience is an asset.

Ticket and Merch Sellers

- Sales staff work at all sports games including soccer, football, hockey, volleyball, and basketball.
- Includes scanning tickets at all home games.
- Set up laptops, terminals, and ticket scanners.
- Take payment from fans, scan tickets, check student identification and stamp hands.
- Staff must be friendly, outgoing and respectful in manner.
- Shifts are outdoors at the UofR Turf Field (Soccer) and Mosaic Stadium (Football, offcampus), indoors at The Co-operators Centre (hockey, off-campus), and indoors at CKHS Gym 3 (Basketball, Volleyball).
- Shifts start approximately 1 hour before game time.
