Quantifier Elimination and Uniform Bounds for Oscillatory Integrals

I will talk about a somewhat unexpected application of model theory to harmonic analysis. Model theory stems from formal logic and can provide very strong results of a general nature, such as the quanitifier elimination theorems of Tarski-Seidenberg and Jan Denef (which I will review). It turns out that these theorems can lead to uniform bounds for families of oscillatory integrals, both over the p-adic fields and over the reals. I will give an overview of these results with a focus on applications in representation theory. This is joint work with Raf Cluckers and Immanuel Halupczok.
