Re: Faculty of Kinesiology and Health Studies's Request for Deferred Unit Review

Dear Dr. Riemer,

At the November meeting of CCAM, the committee further discussed the Faculty of Kinesiology and Health Studies's request to defer its academic unit review (AUR), and the committee decided to grant a one-time extension for the AUR to be conducted in the 2021-2022 review cycle.

The committee reviewed its previous decision on the six-month extension after reviewing the impact this would have on the AUR timelines and recognized the particular challenges posed by COVID-19 on preparing for and conducting a review for the Faculty of Kinesiology and Health Studies at this time. It was decided that it would be beneficial for everyone involved in the review process to have the Faculty of Kinesiology and Health Studies's review to take place under the established AUR timelines (OPS-130-005). This extension will also provide the Faculty of Kinesiology and Health Studies with additional time to engage with the AUR process which will hopefully be beneficial for the faculty as it looks toward the future.
