IMMIGRATION



- Secure your immigration / travel documents in a safe place where they will not get lost or damaged
- Ensure to check and take note of the expiry dates of your immigration / travel documents

 Submit electronic copies of your immigration / travel documents to UR International
- Check in with our UR International team members for support and guidance during your transition to life in Canada

ACADEMIC



- Usit your faculty and book an appointment with your Academic Advisor to discuss your academic plan for success

 Confirm your class schedule and review important dates / deadlines, your class syllabus, and locations for your classes
- Get your University of Regina student ID card by submitting a request through UR Self-Service
- Visit Financial Services (AH 205) to learn about your student financial account and pay your tuition
- Activate your UofR email account by visiting the Information Services website
- Confirm your required textbooks and purchase them through the Campus Store
- Login to UR Self-Service and update your contact information (address, email, phone number, emergency contact)
