**Examinable Material:** The final exam will be comprehensive and will test all of the material covered in Math 111 this semester. This includes everything in Stewart from Sections 1.1 through 5.5, inclusive, except Sections 3.3 and 4.7.

**Exam Specifics:** All Math 111 students take a common final exam. The exam will be graded jointly by all Math 111 instructors.

Your Grade: Your final exam counts for 40%, your best 2 prelims count for 20% each, and your classwork, including quizzes, homework, and office visits, counts for 20%, of your final grade.
