Examinable Material: The final exam will be comprehensive and will test all of the material covered in Math 171 this semester. This includes everything covered in lab, everything in the course packet, and everything in Moore from Chapters 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20 (pages 529–546), 21.

Exam Specifics: All Math 171 students take a common final exam. The exam will be graded jointly by all Math 171 instructors.

Your Grade: Your final exam counts for 40%, your 2 prelims count for 20% each, your homework counts for 15%, and your labs count for 15% of your final grade.
